1. SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES

I understand that participation with Taigun Taijutsu Ryuha may include martial-arts classes, physical conditioning, striking, kicking, blocking, grappling, throws, takedowns, joint manipulation, restraint techniques, falling and rolling, scenario training, seminars, demonstrations, Tai Kai events, outdoor training, private-property activities, and supervised use of traditional martial-arts training weapons or equipment.

2. INHERENT RISKS

I understand that martial arts are contact activities and involve inherent risks. These may include slips, trips, falls, collisions, accidental strikes, strains, sprains, bruises, cuts, fractures, dislocations, joint injury, concussion, head, neck, back or spinal injury, heat or cold exposure, dehydration, terrain hazards, equipment failure, actions of other participants, serious bodily injury, permanent disability, paralysis, or death. I understand that not every possible risk can be listed.

3. VOLUNTARY ASSUMPTION OF RISK

I voluntarily choose to participate. I knowingly accept and assume the inherent and other risks associated with the activities I undertake, whether known or unknown, to the extent permitted by Tennessee law. I understand that reasonable instruction, supervision, protective equipment, and safety rules cannot eliminate every risk.

4. RELEASE OF LIABILITY

To the fullest extent permitted by Tennessee law, I release and discharge Taigun Taijutsu Ryuha, its owners, instructors, assistant instructors, employees, volunteers, agents, representatives, event organizers, and, where applicable, owners or lawful occupiers of property used for training from claims arising from my participation, including claims based on ordinary negligence, to the extent such claims may lawfully be released in advance. This release is not intended to waive liability that cannot legally be waived.

5. PARTICIPANT SAFETY OBLIGATIONS

I agree to obey instructor directions and safety rules; use only authorized techniques and equipment; train within my ability; respect my training partners; immediately report unsafe conditions or damaged equipment; stop when directed or when I believe I cannot safely continue; and refrain from reckless, intentionally harmful, threatening, or unauthorized conduct.

6. WEAPONS AND TRAINING EQUIPMENT

I understand that some instruction may involve traditional martial-arts weapons, replicas, padded weapons, or other training equipment. I will not possess, handle, draw, use, or practice with any weapon or training weapon during an activity unless specifically authorized by the instructor and used in accordance with the instructor's safety directions and applicable law.

7. PHYSICAL CONDITION

I understand that training can be physically demanding. I am responsible for deciding whether I am physically able to participate and for obtaining medical advice when appropriate. I will inform the instructor of limitations that affect safe participation. I understand that instructors are not medical professionals merely because they provide martial-arts instruction.

8. EMERGENCY CARE

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If I am injured or experience a medical emergency and cannot make decisions for myself, I authorize personnel to contact emergency medical services. I understand that immediate medical assistance cannot be guaranteed and that I am responsible for medical and transportation expenses incurred on my behalf except where otherwise required by law.

9. OUTDOOR / PRIVATE-PROPERTY ACTIVITIES

I understand that training may occur outdoors or on private property and may involve uneven ground, wooded areas, weather, natural obstacles, structures, or other environmental conditions. I agree to remain in authorized areas and comply with property, parking, camping, fire, equipment, and safety rules.

10. PERSONAL PROPERTY

I am responsible for my own clothing, equipment, electronics, vehicles, weapons, and other personal property. I understand that Taigun Taijutsu Ryuha does not guarantee the security of personal property.

11. TENNESSEE LAW / SEVERABILITY

This Agreement is intended to be interpreted under Tennessee law. If a provision is determined to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions are intended to remain effective to the fullest extent permitted by law.

FINAL ACKNOWLEDGMENT

I HAVE READ THIS AGREEMENT IN FULL. I UNDERSTAND THE NATURE OF THE ACTIVITIES AND THEIR RISKS. I UNDERSTAND THAT THIS DOCUMENT INCLUDES AN ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND A RELEASE OF CERTAIN LEGAL CLAIMS, INCLUDING CERTAIN CLAIMS INVOLVING ORDINARY NEGLIGENCE, TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY TENNESSEE LAW. I HAVE HAD THE OPPORTUNITY TO ASK QUESTIONS. I SIGN THIS AGREEMENT KNOWINGLY AND VOLUNTARILY.
